Stockholm Concert Hall is one of the leading European concert venues with annual program spanning from the classics to jazz, piano and organ recitals, chamber music, chorus concerts and world music. The resident 105-member Royal Stockholm Philharmonic Orchestra performs about 110 concerts annually, including the Nobel Prize Ceremony, the Stockholm International Composer Festival and Polar Prize Ceremony.

The Concert Hall Music Library's main task is to acquire and prepare music for the Royal Stockholm Philharmonic Orchestra productions, support the artistic planning and archive the organization's concert history.

Principal librarian leads the daily work at the music library and participates in the program department's strategic planning in questions in connection to the library workings. The principal librarian works closely with the publishing industry, other concert institutions, conductors, soloists and agencies to acquire the information needed for music preparation.

A suitable candidate has prior orchestra library experience, has the ability to work independently, possesses strong attention to detail, can cope with stress and unusual situations. Furthermore, the candidate has a comprehensive knowledge of the orchestral repertoire and the workings of a symphony orchestra. Knowledge of the usual computer software is a merit. Good spoken and written English is required, other language skills is a merit. The language used in the administration is Swedish.
